
- Meet practice standards outlined by my regulatory college

- That my patients/clients who are structurally disadvantaged received the services they required







Covid-19 planning, nursing services, and vulnerable patient needs




COVID Planning Meets Patient Needs

Structural Disadvantaged Patients Needs Met






COVID Planning Meet Patient Needs

My practice setting respects my professional practice


- I am more concerned and/or stressed about meeting the professional practice standards outlined by my regulatory college

- I worry that I will bring the virus home to my family







Stress Nurses are Experiencing









Increased Stress in COVID-19 Context















Worried about Bringing COVID-19 Home









Nurses Mental and Physical Health

- I feel that my practice setting is structured to support nurses wellbeing (time to debrief, staffing, organizational leadership)








- I plan to leave the nursing profession immediately






Plans for Transitions in Nursing Profession




Solutions
