Close the Wage Gap

DSPs are paid 17% less, as compared to other occupations with similar education requirements.

Despite providing critical services that people with disabilities rely upon, their average wage is only \$13.15 per hour.



Workforce Crisis

Nearly two-thirds of DSPs quit in the first year. More than 40% of supervisors also leave in the first year. There are 20,000+ open positions statewide. This puts continuous care for people with disabilities at risk.



Access to Support

Inequitable access to reliable technology, housing and transportation all threaten a person with a disability's right to live a fulfilling and independent life.
