

**American Society of Blood and Marrow Transplantation (ASBMT)
Nursing Special Interest Group (SIG) Lifetime Achievement Award**

A Lifetime Achievement Award will be awarded to an ASBMT Nursing SIG member who has made a significant impact in the field of blood and marrow transplantation nursing and has been in practice for at least ten years. The Lifetime Achievement Award will recognize an individual who has made consistent and high quality contributions to the field of blood and marrow transplantation including publications, presentations, mentoring, volunteering in professional organizations and serving in leadership positions within professional organizations.

The recipient of this award will receive a recognition plaque to be presented at the annual nursing conference at the TANDEM ASBMT/CIBMTR meeting. Additionally, the conference registration fee will be waived for that year's conference.

Eligibility:

Must be a current member of ASBMT.

Must have been practicing as a nurse in the field of blood and marrow transplantation for at least 10 years.

Points will be awarded as follows:

Contributions	Points Awarded
Publications	Journal article = 5 points Book Chapter = 10 points Abstract = 2 points
Presentations	5 points
Mentoring	10 points
Volunteering in Professional organization	10 points/year
Leadership Position in Professional organization	15 points/year
