



### **Call for ASBMT Pharmacy Award Nominations**

Please help recognize your colleagues for their outstanding work and dedication to pharmacy in hematopoietic cell transplantation (HCT) by nominating them for an American Society for Blood and Marrow Transplantation (ASBMT) Pharmacy SIG Award. Nominees can be either pharmacists or pharmacy technicians, but must be ASBMT Pharmacy SIG members. The deadline for nominations is **September 30, 2018**. The three awards that we are accepting nominations for include the Lifetime Achievement Award, New Practitioner Award, and Excellence in Advocacy Award (see below for details). These awards will be presented at the annual BMT Pharmacists Conference held in conjunction with the Transplantation and Cellular Therapy (TCT) Meeting of ASBMT and CIBMTR in February 2019. In order to be considered for an award, the nominator must submit a nomination form and current curriculum vitae of the nominee. Self-nominations will be accepted.

#### **Lifetime Achievement Award**

This award will recognize an ASBMT Pharmacy SIG member who has made a significant impact to the field of pharmacy in HCT and has been in practice for at least 10 years (not inclusive of post-graduate/residency training). This award will recognize an individual who has made consistent and high-quality contributions to the field of HCT, including but not limited to publications, presentations, mentorship, and leadership.

#### **New Practitioner Award**

This award will recognize an ASBMT Pharmacy SIG member who is within the first 5 years of his/her career (not inclusive of post-graduate/residency training) and who has made significant contributions to the field of HCT as it applies to pharmacy practice including but not limited to publications, presentations, mentorship, and leadership.

#### **Excellence in Advocacy Award**

This award will recognize an ASBMT Pharmacy SIG member who has made a significant impact to the field of pharmacy in hematopoietic cell transplantation (HCT) through patient and/or practice advocacy. It will recognize an individual that has displayed a commitment to advancing the practice of HCT to improve the delivery of patient care, while incorporating and promoting the role of the pharmacist in the management of HCT patients.
