# MEDICARE APPROVES TOTAL SHOULDERS AND ANKLES IN ASCS

In an unanticipated move, <u>Medicare approved</u> total shoulder arthroplasty (CPT 23472), shoulder hemi-arthroplasty (23470) and total ankle arthroplasty (27702) for payment in ASCs beginning January 1, 2024. ASCA had long advocated for these codes to be moved to the ASC Covered Procedures List; however, approval was not expected this year after the codes were left out of the proposed payment rule in July.

Overall, ASCs will see a 3.1% effective payment update in 2024. As always, ASCA released an **overview of the final rule** to its members upon the rule's release.

# DOCTORS CONTINUE PUSH FOR PAYMENT RELIEF

Numerous stakeholders across the healthcare community continue to press Congress for relief from impending cuts to Medicare physician reimbursement. Physicians are in line for a 3.37% rate cut and a fourth straight year of declining reimbursement unless Congress acts.


ASCA has been active on this issue, signing on to multiple **coalition letters** and encouraging ASCA members to contact their congressional representatives. As of early December, it seems unlikely that Congress will provide relief by year's end, but it might provide retroactive relief via legislation in early 2024.
