## **Professional Farm Manager of the Year Award**

The Professional Farm Manager of the Year Award recognizes an AFM accredited member or team who has made an impact on the farm management profession. This year the award was presented to Allen Hatley, AFM and Tim Cobb, AFM of Hatley/Cobb Farmland Management of Spokane, Washington.

## **Appraisal Professional of the Year**

The 2017 Appraisal Professional of the Year was awarded to Wendell C. Wood, ARA. Each year ASFMRA recognizes an ARA or RPRA accredited member for their impact on the profession through appraisal education, service on professional appraisal boards, community involvement and affirmation of their professionalism and excellence within the appraisal profession. ### **D. Howard Doane Award**

The 2017 D. Howard Doane Award was presented to Kirk D. Weih, AFM of Hertz Farm Management, Inc. in Mount Vernon, Iowa. The D.
