## Call for Submissions – Special Issue of the Journal of the ASFMRA focused on Rural Appraisal

Have you run across an interesting or challenging situation in your appraisal work? Have you learned from your appraisal experiences and believe others may benefit from those experiences? Do you conduct research related to rural appraisal? If the answer to any of these questions is "yes," then please consider submitting an article for the upcoming special issue of the *Journal of the ASFMRA* focusing on appraisal topics that are of interest to rural property professionals. Articles in this issue may take many forms, including case studies, short communications, or presentation of formal research.

To submit an article for consideration in this special issue, please send the following materials as email attachments to <u>publications@asfmra.org</u>:

- Cover letter. In a cover letter accompanying the manuscript, (a) indicate why the manuscript would interest JASFMRA readers; (b) certify that the material in the submitted manuscript (or modification thereof) has not been published, is not being published, and is not being considered for publication elsewhere; and (c) stipulate that the material in the manuscript, to the best of the author's knowledge, does not infringe upon other published material protected by copyright.
- 2. Manuscript. Your manuscript should not exceed 5,000 words in length, not counting the references or footnotes. Please submit your manuscript as a Microsoft Word document, double-spaced using 12-point Times New Roman font. Please use left justification and allow 1" margins on all sides, and include page numbers and line numbers, with line numbers running consecutively throughout the manuscript. Your manuscript should include an abstract of 100 words or fewer, along with any tables and figures, and a complete list of references.

Submissions are due by March 22, 2024, with initial decisions expected in May 2024 and anticipated publication in September 2024.

## About the Journal:

The Journal of the ASFMRA is an open-access online journal published by the American Society of Farm Managers and Rural Appraisers. The Journal's editorial board consists of the editor and members of the ASFMRA Editorial Task Force, which includes academic and professional members of the ASFMRA.
