2026 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (\$500-\$5,000 Awards)

ASM-International, Houston Chapter General Fund

Applicants must:

1. Be a full-time graduate or undergraduate student.
2. Be enrolled in a college of engineering or science. (Graduate students must be enrolled in a Materials Science and Engineering program.)
3. Maintain at least a “C” grade average.
4. Be a citizen of the United States of America OR an ASM member

Preference will be given to applicants with an interest in materials science, academic excellence, financial need, and Texas residency.

C.F. Lewis Memorial Fund

Applicants must:

1. Be enrolled in a college of engineering or science.
2. Show an active interest in materials science.
3. Use the funds for the final two years of undergraduate study.
4. Be in the family of a Houston Chapter, ASM-International member OR a Texas resident at an eligible Texas college of engineering or science.
5. Maintain at least a “C” grade average.
6. Be a citizen of the United States of America.

Wayne Quantz Memorial Fund

Applicants must:

- 1 The candidate for the scholarship must be enrolled in a college of engineering or science. He or she shall have a major or minor in metallurgy or materials science or shall show a very active interest in the field of materials science.
- 2 The scholarship(s) shall be limited to families of members of the Houston Chapter of ASM International, or Texas residents attending eligible schools with a college of engineering or science.
- 3 The candidate must have a passing grade point average.
- 4 The candidate must be citizen of the United States of America.
- 5 The need for financial assistance may be a factor in the selection of a candidate. Therefore, the financial status of applicants should be determined including place of employment, number of hours candidate works per week, additional scholarships the candidate may be receiving and the percent of college expenses earned by applicant.
