Charter

Committee Purpose

The purpose of the Coding Committee is to monitor the introduction of new and the revision of existing medical billing coding regulations in reproductive medicine and provide guidance, as appropriate, to reproductive medicine specialists.

Committee Structure

The Coding Committee is comprised of a Chair and seven appointed members, including, representatives of the five affiliated societies and two at-large members. The ASRM Executive Director and the ASRM Scientific Director serve ex officio on the Coding Committee. The appointment terms of the chair and all committee members shall be three years, with one third expiring annually. The Committee utilizes the expertise of external consultants when necessary.

Committee Functions

- Reviews existing and new billing codes applicable to reproductive medicine, including male and female infertility.
- Considers the need for new codes and develops documentation to support requests for code revisions.
- Answers coding questions from reproductive healthcare professionals.
- Provides appropriate educational tools and activities to educate reproductive health professionals in the proper use of billing codes.
- Provides semiannual progress reports to the Board of Directors

• Meeting Cadence

- The Coding Committee meets annually for an in-person meeting, corresponding with the ASRM annual Scientific Congress Meeting. Additional longer in-person meetings can be called, as needed, for address committee work related to ongoing projects.

• Committee Reporting

- The annual Committee report is disseminated to the Board of Directors each Spring during the Board of Directors meeting.
