Mission Statement

Committee Purpose

The purpose of the Membership Committee is to support the work of the ASRM Member Services Department by assisting in the development of membership initiatives and volunteering for membership-related programs. By identifying gaps in service and serving as a multi-disciplinary sounding board, the Membership Committee represents the needs of the ASRM membership as a whole.

Committee Structure

The Membership Committee is comprised of a Chair, Vice Chair, Immediate Past Chair, and ten appointed members, including, representatives of the five affiliated societies, the Mental Health Professional Group, the Nurses Professional Group, the Legal Professional Group, the Association of Reproductive Managers, and the Women's Council. Committee members are selected based on their demonstrated interest in building the membership of the Society. The ASRM Executive Director, the ASRM Director of Operations, and the ASRM Member Services Manager serve ex officio on the Membership Committee. The appointment terms of the chair and all committee members shall be three years, with one third expiring annually. The Committee utilizes the expertise of external consultants when necessary.

Committee Functions

- Promotes the benefits of ASRM membership to current and potential members.
- Promotes membership in ASRM affiliated societies, professional groups, and special interest groups.
- Provides feedback and insight to the Member Services Department about ideas to improve member recruitment, retention, and customer service.
- Provides feedback to other ASRM committees about membership-related initiatives.
- Provides volunteers for membership-related programs at the ASRM Annual Meeting.
- Provides semiannual progress reports to the Board of Directors
