Urotrauma Guiding Principles

1. To secure from Congress and policy makers, for military victims of battlefield genitourinary trauma, the same policy stature and proportional resource allocation as extremity and neurocognitive injury (PTSD and TBI).
2. To work with coalition partners to enhance prevention of, optimize initial management of, and better coordinate the chronic management of battlefield genitourinary trauma for service members in the DoD and VA.
3. To enhance the research infrastructure for the continuous study and improvement of the continuum of care of battlefield urotrauma.
4. To raise public awareness of the scope and urgency of the issue in order to raise urotrauma's profile as a public policy priority.
