AUPHA ANNOUNCES FULL LAUNCH OF COMPENSATION & BENEFITS PORTAL

ARLINGTON, Va. – The Association of University Programs in Health Administration (AUPHA) is pleased to announce the full launch of the Compensation & Benefits portal, a part of the Benchmarking for Education in Healthcare Management (BEHM) platform. Soft launched in March 2013 for a data collection phase, the portal now allows participants to compare their compensation and benefits data and download reports based on pre-set filters, such as Position, Gender, Age, Ethnicity, and Academic Setting, in either Adobe or PowerPoint formats. The portal replaces the annual Faculty Compensation Survey, which was previously completed at the program level, but now allows individual faculty the opportunity to report this data and pull information pertinent to their position.

The BEHM platform was originally launched in June 2012 as a single portal for programs to report their yearly program data and then benchmark themselves against other AUPHA member programs. Now a multidimensional platform with both an Operations portal and Compensation & Benefits portal, BEHM provides AUPHA program members even more opportunity to better lead their programs and careers by identifying best practices as well as areas for improvement and advancement.
