**JENNIFER CHUBINSKI, PhD, NAMED 2023 RECIPIENT OF
THE GLANDON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FOR ADVANCEMENT
OF
HEALTHCARE MANAGEMENT EDUCATION**

WASHINGTON, D.C., February 14, 2023 – Jennifer Chubinski, PhD, Assistant Professor and Director of the Undergraduate Program, Health Services Administration, Xavier University, Cincinnati, Ohio, has been named the fourth recipient of the Glandon Family Scholarship for Advancement of Healthcare Management Education. Dr. Chubinski will be formally recognized at AUPHA’s Annual Awards Presentation held on July 1, 2023, at the Gaylord Resort and Convention Center, National Harbor, Maryland.

The Scholarship was established in the fall of 2019 to create an endowment for a faculty scholarship at an AUPHA member program, with the intent of creating a durable legacy in support of quality healthcare management education. The scholarship is aimed at future educational leaders by giving them recognition and financial support at an early stage of their academic career. The Scholarship is named after former AUPHA President and CEO, Gerald L. Glandon, PhD.

“Dr. Chubinski’s strong commitment to her students was abundantly clear, in her own statement, and the letters from her Chair, faculty colleague, and a current student,” said Dan Gentry, PhD, MHA, President and CEO of AUPHA. “Dr. Chubinski’s plan for the Glandon Family Scholarship funds is intentional and important: one, to implement more applied, experiential learning techniques in her undergraduate classes; and two, to further develop her content expertise for teaching Human Resources Management at the graduate level. These efforts will impact more than 200 undergraduate students and greater than 100 graduate students over the next five years.

“I am deeply moved to have been chosen for this very competitive and prestigious Glandon Family Scholarship,” said Dr. Chubinski. “I am thrilled to have additional financial resources to build on my teaching skills in Health Services Administration. The investment will benefit my students and my Department. Many thanks for this generous gift.”
