Christy Harris Lemak, is Professor and former Chair of the Department of Health Services Administration in the School of Health Professions at the University of Alabama at Birmingham. She also serves as Deputy Director of the Marnix E. Heersink Institute for Biomedical Innovation in the University of Alabama Heersink School of Medicine and serves as an Executive-in-Residence at the Scottsdale Institute.

Dr. Lemak's research and teaching focus on leadership and high performance in health care. Her current research examines leadership to accelerate the health care's digital transformation. Dr. Lemak currently serves on the boards of the not-for-profit Community Hospital Corporation (Plano, TX) and the Alabama Healthcare Hall of Fame. She was the recipient of the 2022 AUPHA Filerman Prize for Educational Leadership. Dr. Lemak previously held faculty and leadership positions in health administration at the University of Michigan and the University of Florida.
