



Dr. Johnson is the Director of the Institute of Health Administration, the Joe Taylor Chair in Health Administration, the Lofton Family Professor, and a Professor of Health Administration in the J. Mack Robinson College of Business at Georgia State University. He is best known for work that seeks to understand how health care organizations impact health care outcomes for Veterans, underserved populations, and the elderly. His early work focused on care within medical groups within managed care environments, which resulted in two national best paper awards. He led and participated in grants funded by the National Science Foundation (NSF), The Commonwealth Fund, Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality, VA Health Services Research & Development, CMS State-University Partnership Program (KY), State of Florida's Agency for Health Care Administration, Novartis, and HealthGrades, Inc. Dr. Johnson is a current member of the Accreditation Council, Standards Committee, and Candidacy Committee and site visitor for the Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare Management Education (CAHME).
