



Jacob Victory, MPA, is Associate Clinical Professor of Public Service at NYU Wagner, where he serves as Director of the MPA in Health Policy and Management and Director of the MS in Health Law and Strategy (MSHLS), a joint graduate program sponsored by NYU Law and NYU Wagner. He also serves as an advisor to Essen Health, Recora, and AIRnyc.

Professor Victory brings more than 27 years of executive leadership experience in Medicaid, post-acute care, long-term services and supports (LTSS), managed care, and home- and community-based care. Most recently, he was President of Medicaid Home Care at BAYADA Home Health Care, overseeing operations in nine states and a workforce of 6,000 serving thousands of patients daily. Previously, as Senior Vice President of Medicaid Long-Term Care at Centene Corporation, he led a \$2.6 billion Florida-market LTSS health plan serving 61,000 medically complex members and directed major WellCare post-acquisition integration efforts. His prior executive roles include Chief Operating Officer of The New Jewish Home, executive roles within Centerlight PACE and VNS Health, and earlier strategic planning positions at NewYork-Presbyterian Hospital and Cabrini Medical Center.

He holds a BA in English Literature (with honors) and Finance from Rutgers University and an MPA in Health Policy and Management from NYU Wagner, where he was also an adjunct professor of healthcare policy and management for 17 years.
