



Dr. Nir Menachemi serves as the Dean of the Fairbanks School of Public Health. He is the Fairbanks Endowed Chair and holds the rank of professor. He also holds an appointment as scientist with the Regenstrief Institute. Dr. Menachemi's work focuses at the intersection of health policy, medicine, and business. As a health services researcher, much of his work has focused on cost, quality, and access to care in the U.S.

Before being appointed dean on June 15, 2024, he served as interim dean, executive associate dean & chief operating officer of the Fairbanks School of Public Health. In addition, he was chair of the Department of Health Policy & Management from 2015-2022. Prior to joining the faculty at Indiana University Indianapolis, Dr. Menachemi held faculty positions at the UAB School of Public Health and the Florida State University College of Medicine.

Dr. Menachemi has published more than 300 peer-reviewed scientific papers, and his work has appeared in numerous prestigious professional journals, including Health Affairs, New England Journal of Medicine, Health Services Research, and the American Journal of Public Health.
