



## Urban Air Mobility (UAM) Ecosystem Working Groups

**PURPOSE:** The working groups aim to accelerate the development of safe, high-volume UAM flight operations by bringing together the broad community involved in developing this new capability.

**EXECUTION:** On March 10 – 12, 2020, NASA will kick off the working groups with a 2.5 day interactive workshop in the Washington DC area. To follow, there will be consistent virtual and in-person gatherings to continue to facilitate community engagement and input in the UAM ecosystem.

We are seeking broad and diverse inputs, including aircraft developers, infrastructure and airspace providers, and members of the broader community (government, venture capitalists, public interest groups, trade organizations, professional societies, etc.).

**BENEFITS:** Participation in the working groups will give contributors the opportunity to closely collaborate with NASA and other government organizations towards developing the standards, policies, and operationalization of UAM. Moreover, the participants will receive regular updates regarding the current state of the UAM ecosystem, allowing them to determine where they can provide the best value to their organizations and the industry as a whole.
