Point earning opportunities are subject to change. There may be additional point earning opportunities in the future. All chapters will be notified of these changes, but are encouraged to check the website regularly for updates.

Additional Details for Each Opportunity to Earn Engagement Points:

Category: Membership Acceptance/Recognition

Overall Acceptance Rate: Your chapter will be awarded the same number of points as your overall acceptance rate (i.e. 85% acceptance rate earns 85 points). Acceptance rates are calculated over an academic year (July 1 –June 30). These points can only be earned once per academic year. Students must accept membership by June 30 in order to be included in the acceptance rate calculations. Any student who accepts membership on July 1 and after will be calculated into the next academic year's acceptance rate.

Increase Overall Acceptance Rate by 10% from Last Year: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points if your overall acceptance rate has increased by 10% from the previous year. Acceptance rates are calculated over an academic year. These points can only be earned once per academic year. You must induct students and submit your Chapter Year in Review Survey for two consecutive years to earn these points.

Increase Overall Acceptance Rate by 25% from Last Year: Your chapter will be awarded 10 points if your overall acceptance rate has increased by 25% from the previous year. Acceptance rates are calculated over an academic year. These points can only be earned once per academic year. You must induct students and submit your Chapter Year in Review Survey for two consecutive years to earn these points.

Induct Second Semester Sophomores/2nd Year Students: Your chapter will be awarded 10 points for inducting second semester sophomores/2nd year students. These points can only be earned once per academic year.

Induct First Semester Juniors/3rd Year Students: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points for inducting first semester juniors/3rd year students. These points can only be earned once per academic year.

Induct Doctoral Students: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points for inducting doctoral students. These points can only be earned once per academic year.

Induct Eligible Faculty: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points for inducting eligible Faculty. These points can only be earned once per academic year.

Host a Tapping Ceremony to Invite Students: Your chapter will be awarded 10 points for hosting a tapping ceremony per Recognition Ceremony (i.e. If you hold a tapping ceremony October 10, 2016 for your ceremony on December 10, 2016 and a tapping ceremony on February 10, 2017 for your ceremony on April 10, 2017 your chapter will be awarded 20 points). These points can be earned each term per academic year.

Your chapter will not receive multiple points if you hold multiple tapping ceremonies for the same Recognition Ceremony (i.e. If you have a ceremony set for December 14, 2016 and you tap your students October 11, 15 and 30, 2016, your chapter will only receive 10 points).

Host a BGS Information Session Your chapter will be awarded 5 points for hosting a BGS Information Session. These points can be earned once per term each academic year.

Host a BGS Information Table: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points for hosting a BGS Information Table. These points can be earned once per term each academic year.

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Collegiate Chapter Honor Roll Requirements

Recognize members at commencement (i.e. regalia- honor stoles or honor cords, program listing, or announcement):

Your chapter will be awarded 10 points for recognizing members at commencement. These points can be earned once per commencement each academic year. Multiple points are not awarded for several recognitions at the same commencement (i.e. announcement and program listing does not award your chapter 20 points for that particular commencement).

Host a Recognition Ceremony (at least one per year): Your chapter will be awarded 10 points for holding a Recognition Ceremony. These points can be earned once per ceremony per term each academic year.

Category: Programs & Activities

Have active student officers: If your chapter has active student officers in place, your chapter will be awarded 10 points. You must submit the officer name and position title to your chapter manager to earn these points. Points for student officers can only be earned once per academic year.

Send a student to the Global Leadership Summit (GLS): If your chapter sends one or more students to the Global Leadership Summit, your chapter will be awarded 10 points per student in attendance. These points can be earned each academic year.

Attend Collegiate Chapter Training Seminar (during the last 3 academic years): If your chapter has had one or more attendee at the Collegiate Chapter Training Seminar during the last three academic years, your chapter will be awarded 5 points per attendee. These points can be earned each academic year.

Participate in the BGS Gives Back: Chapters can earn a total of 10 points for participating in BGS Gives Back. To be eligible for points, chapters must register the event using the online registration form available on the BGS website. The registration form must be completed by the deadline of the correlating academic year's Chapter Year in Review survey to be eligible. Chapters can choose to do a service project in the name of BGS any time during the academic year to be eligible for points; however, these points can only be earned once per academic year.

Host an on-campus event in addition to a Recognition Ceremony (i.e. speaker event, career panel, etc.): Your chapter will be awarded 10 points for each event held outside of having a Recognition Ceremony. If your chapter has not held a Recognition Ceremony in the last academic year, you would not be eligible to receive points in this category. In order to receive these points, chapters must provide a date and description for each event when completing the Year In Review. These points can be earned for each event held per academic year.

Host a collaborative event with a BGS Alumni Chapter: Your chapter will be awarded 10 points per event held in conjunction with a BGS Alumni Chapter. In order to receive points in this category, chapters must provide a date and description for each event to their Chapter Manager. These points can be earned for each event held per academic year.

Graduate program participation in the Virtual Graduate School Fair: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points each time you register to participate in the Virtual Graduate School Fair. Points will not be awarded for students attending the fair. These points can be earned each academic year.

Award a Chapter Honoree: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points per Chapter Honoree. Your chapter may invite a maximum of two chapter honorees per academic year. These points can be earned each academic year.

Collegiate Chapter Honor Roll Requirements

Have the BGS Bronze Key displayed on campus: If your chapter has a BGS Bronze Key displayed on campus, your chapter will earn 5 points. These points can only be earned once per academic year.

Category: Nominations & Awards

Submit a nomination for the Medallion for Entrepreneurship Award: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points per nomination submitted for the Medallion for Entrepreneurship Award. If someone nominated by your chapter is selected, your chapter will receive 5 additional points. These points can be earned for each nomination submitted per academic year.

Submit a nomination for the Business Achievement Award: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points per nomination submitted for the Business Achievement Award. If someone nominated by your chapter is selected, your chapter will receive 5 additional points. These points can be earned for each nomination submitted per academic year.

Submit a nomination for the Outstanding Chapter Award, if qualified: BGS will notify your chapter if you are qualified to submit this nomination. If qualified, your chapter will be awarded 5 points per nomination submitted for the Outstanding Chapter Award. If the chapter you have nominated is selected, your chapter will receive 5 additional points. These points can be earned for each nomination submitted per academic year.

Submit a nomination for the Outstanding Chapter Advisor Award, if qualified: BGS will notify your chapter if you are qualified to submit this nomination. If qualified, your chapter will be awarded 5 points per nomination submitted for the Outstanding Chapter Advisor Award. If someone nominated by your chapter is selected, your chapter will receive 5 additional points. These points can be earned for each nomination submitted per academic year.

Submit a nomination for the Dean of the Year Award, if qualified: BGS will notify your chapter if you are qualified to submit this nomination. If qualified, your chapter will be awarded 5 points per nomination submitted for the Dean of the Year Award. If the chapter you have nominated is selected, your chapter will receive 5 additional points. These points can be earned for each nomination submitted per academic year.

Award Professor of the Year to a BGS faculty member on your campus: Your chapter will be awarded 5 points for each individual that receives the Professor of the Year Award. To participate, chapters should create a roster of business school faculty members who are also members of the Society. Chapter members would then vote for and select the BGS Professor of the Year. These points can be earned for each individual awarded Professor of the Year per academic year.
