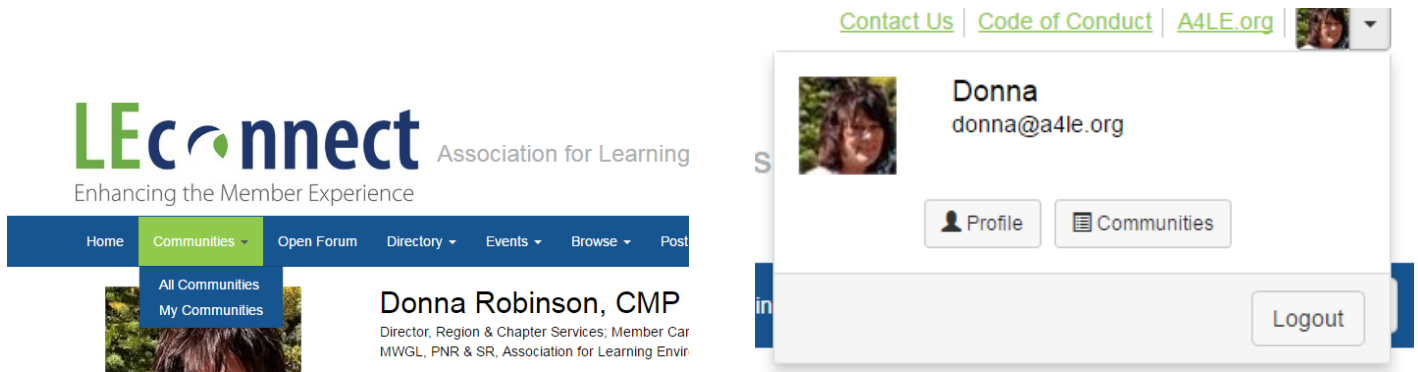


# Communities
