You'll be working remotely and will have significant autonomy. That freedom comes with responsibility. This role requires self-motivation, intellectual honesty, and pride in the quality of your thinking and communication.

What you'll do

You'll contribute original macro and investment ideas, help shape research themes, and turn thinking into clear, well-structured writing. You'll publish articles, develop charts and visuals consistent with the Stray Reflections style, and actively participate in — and help lead — discussions within our Slack community.

What I'm looking for

You don't need decades of experience. You do need genuine curiosity, strong analytical instincts, and the ability to express ideas clearly in writing. You should enjoy markets enough that you'd be thinking about them even if no one were paying you to. You should be comfortable working independently, forming your own views, and defending them thoughtfully.

Strong communication matters. If you can't explain an idea simply, you don't understand it well enough yet.

3. One complete investment idea, including:
 - A clear written thesis
 - Detailed analysis
 - Supporting charts designed to reflect the Stray Reflections visual brand
