Criteria:

To be considered for Student Membership in the CFA Society Nebraska, the following criteria must be met:

- You must be enrolled in a university/college as one of the following:
 - I. a full-time undergraduate student pursuing a bachelor's degree, or
 - II. a university/college as a full- or part-time graduate student pursuing a graduate degree.
- You must agree to be bound by the CFA Institute Code of Ethics and Standards of Professional Conduct.

CFA Institute membership is not required for Student Membership in the CFA Society Nebraska. An individual may be a Student member of the CFA Society Nebraska for a combined maximum of three years. The membership year is July - June.

Application:

Applicants are required to submit the following documents and payment in order to be considered for student membership:

- Completed Student Membership Application, signed by an instructor at the college/ university where you are enrolled. (Applies to initial application and renewals.)
- 200-500 word essay on importance of ethics in the conduct of business in the global economy. (Required only with initial application. Not needed for renewals.)
- \$25 annual membership dues (credit card or check payable to CFA Society Nebraska).
 Dues are not prorated. (Applies to initial application and renewals.)
