- Collaborate with internal staff and external consultants to improve and execute manager research for all asset classes across portfolios, including retained and potential managers.
- Use systems like Bipsync, MSCI Total Plan, and Bloomberg to manage our manager research process.

### What you need:

- MBA or business-related master's degree required. CFA/CAIA senior designation preferred.
- At least 15 years of institutional investment experience required, including areas such as manager research, portfolio management, policy formulation, securities trading, distribution, business development, or credit research. Other relevant investment backgrounds are considered. Preference given to candidates with not-for-profit investment management or board-level experience.
