CFA Society Greece announces the **4th CFA Society Greece Research Award**, to distinguish outstanding scientific and empirical research in the relevant fields of study in investment, finance, economics, business and accounting.

Tender

CFA Society Greece is pleased to accept submissions for its fourth annual CFA Society Greece Research Award. An anonymous review by the jury will select papers in the relevant fields of study in investment, finance, economics, business and accounting research, in connection to their scientific contribution and practical relevance. Papers should be formulated clearly, structured transparently and supported by sufficient evidence, provide valuable insights for professionals in the fields of study and be accessible to non-specialist readers in such fields.

Prize

The CFA Society Greece Research Award is endowed with €2,000 for the winning paper. In the case of grading parity, the above prize will be split equally among the winning papers. The prize winner(s) will be invited to a signature event of the Society (e.g., Forecast Dinner). The winner(s) will also be invited to present the findings of their paper to the Society members in a webinar, in addition to having the study published on the Society website.

Eligibility & Requirements

We welcome submissions of *only papers published in the last three (3) years* from professionals working in the fields of study in Greece and from academic scholars enrolled at Universities and Institutions of Higher Education in Greece. Papers should not exceed 40 pages and must be accompanied by a 2-page summary, may be written in English or Greek and should be submitted in pdf format. **Each author may submit up to two (2) papers.**

Past winners are not eligible to participate for a period of two (2) years

Consent

By accepting the award, the laureate(s) agree(s) to the publication of their name, their paper and their photo including all reproductions, extracts and adaptations to be used by CFA Society Greece in media (including website, social media and print) for promotional purposes. The waiver of copyright for the purposes of such publication is a prerequisite for winner nomination.

Selection Process & Announcement

An independent jury comprised of field experts will assess the submissions. The winners shall be announced on our website.
