- Scholarships are open to candidates pursuing all levels.
- Candidates are ineligible if their current employer provides any financial assistance for participation in the CFA program.
- Scholarships can be awarded even if a candidate has already registered for 2026 exams.
- Candidates must sit for the exam in 2026 and provide proof in order to receive a scholarship payment.
- Candidates who are college students at the time of registration can sit for the exam in any location.
- Candidates who are college students must be a student of a CFA Society Milwaukee partner institution.
- Candidates who are not students must reside within the jurisdiction of the CFA Society Milwaukee (Fox Cities, Milwaukee, Racine, Kenosha, etc.).
