- Develop, implement, and monitor standards, policies, and procedures for banking and payment processes.
- Ensure compliance with internal controls, regulatory requirements, and banking rules.
- Maintain documentation to meet legal and regulatory standards. Banking Strategy & Relationship Management:
- Formulate and communicate banking strategies aligned with BC Hydro's goals.
- Negotiate and manage banking arrangements to meet business needs and optimize service quality and cost efficiency.
