For the singular purpose of registration of the Society in Tanzania as a Branch of CFA Society in East Africa and under local laws and regulations, the Society Board Members shall identify and appoint three (3) local and active Tanzania members (Regular) as ‘Office Bearers’ namely Chair, Secretary and Treasurer for the Tanzania Chapter</p> <p>II. One (1) out of the three (3) local Tanzania members MUST be an elected and currently sitting Board Member representing the Tanzania Chapter</p> <p>III. The three (3) selected members MUST be members in good standing, maintaining their active membership for a minimum of atleast three (3) consecutive years</p>
