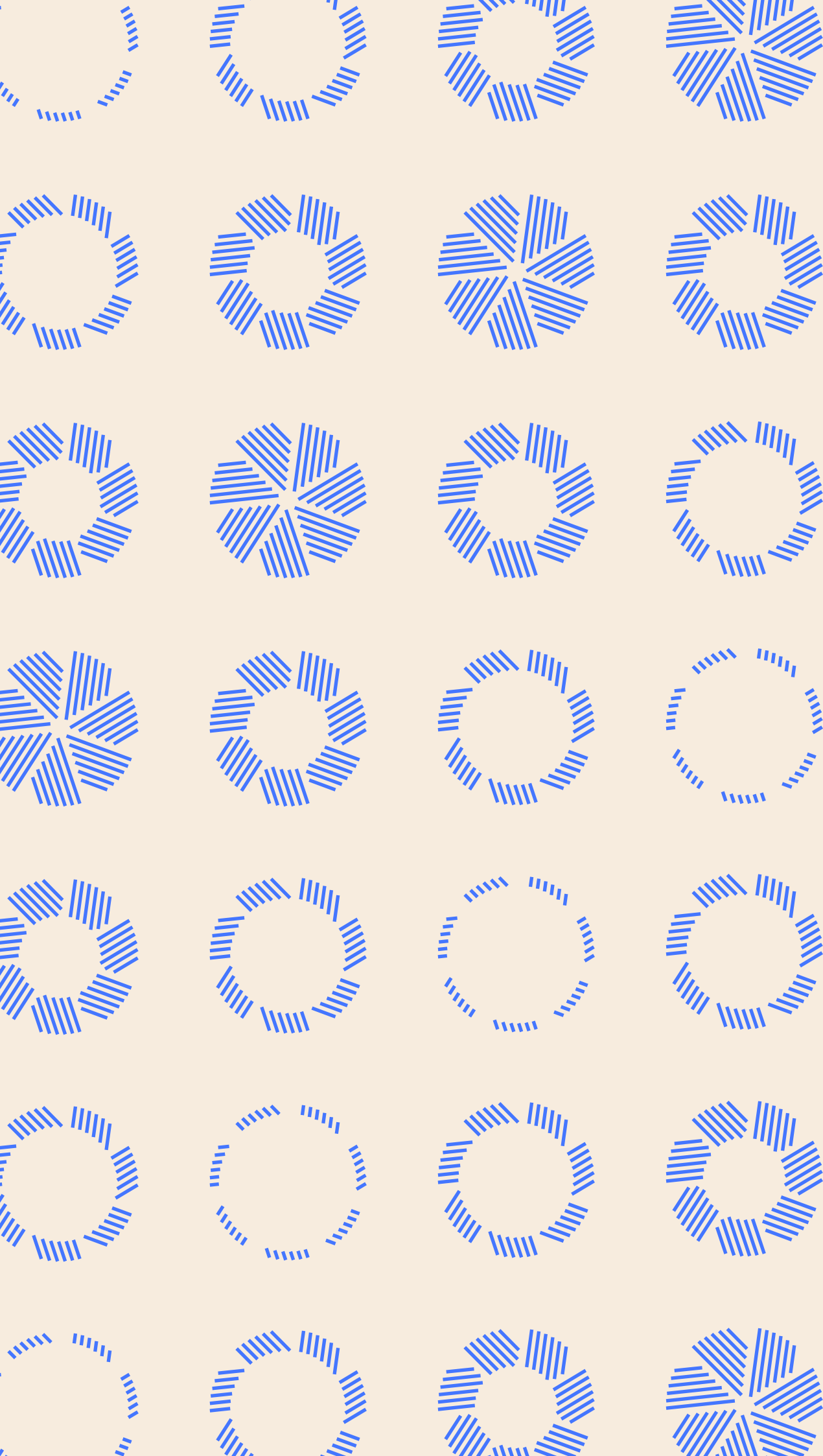

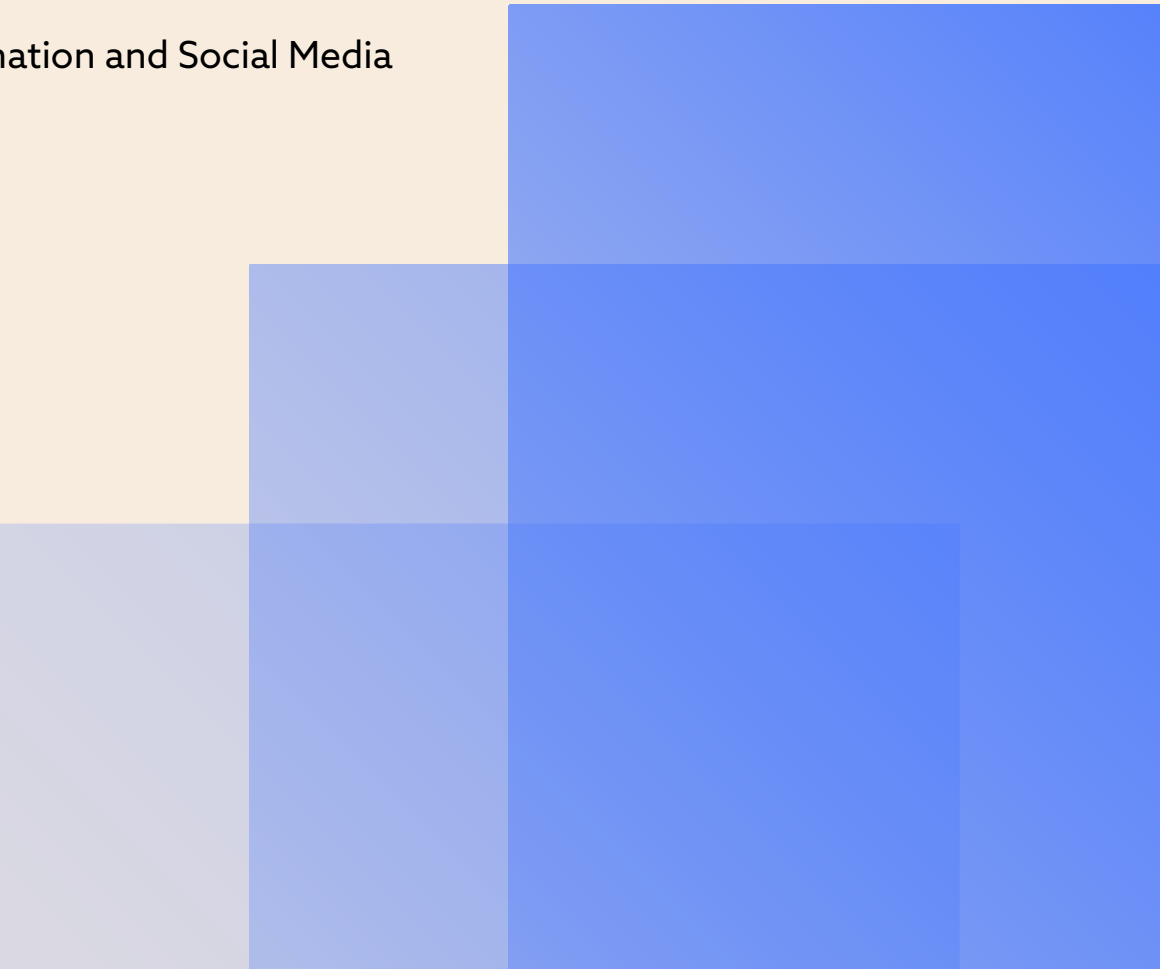

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Review of Past 6 Months

As we reach the midpoint of 2026, we are pleased to reflect on another active and rewarding period for CFA Society Istanbul. The first six months of the year have been marked by continued growth, strong member engagement, meaningful industry outreach, and a steadfast commitment to advancing the highest standards of ethics, education, and professionalism across the investment profession.

Our Society continues to grow at a remarkable pace. Membership has now surpassed 550 members, the highest level in our history. Five years ago, our Society had approximately 280 members; today, we are proud to serve a community that has nearly doubled in size. This growth reflects both the increasing recognition of the CFA designation and the collective efforts of our volunteers, members, and stakeholders who continue to strengthen our professional community.

Industry engagement remained a key priority throughout the period. Over the past twelve months, we conducted more than 50 employer outreach visits, meeting with financial institutions, corporates, asset managers, regulators, and other stakeholders across Türkiye and our broader region. These conversations help strengthen awareness of the CFA Program, support professional development, and deepen relationships with organizations that value excellence in investment management.

Professional learning and thought leadership continued to be at the heart of our activities. In February, we hosted the 12th Women in Finance event, bringing together accomplished professionals and future leaders to discuss career development, leadership, and diversity in the investment profession. In June, we organized the Private Markets Summit, creating an important platform for dialogue around one of the fastest-growing segments of global finance.

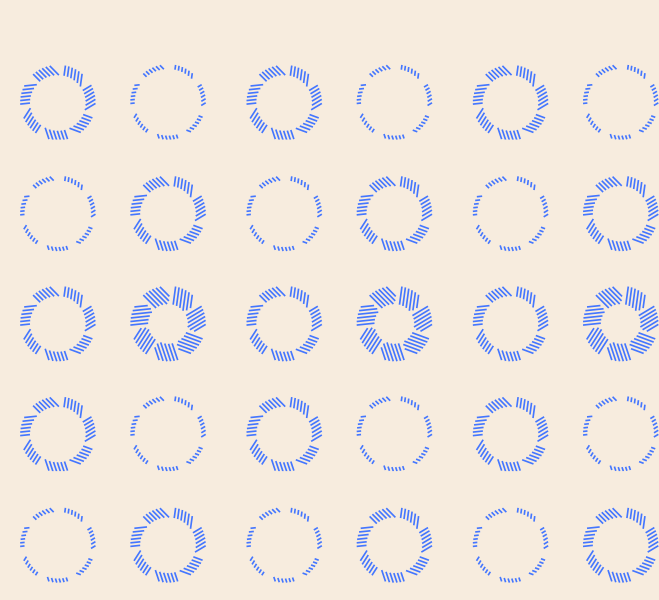

The CFA Institute Research Challenge once again attracted strong participation from universities across Türkiye and neighboring countries, providing students with valuable hands-on experience in equity research, valuation, ethics, and presentation skills. We were also pleased to announce Borusan Pipe as the subject company for the 2026–2027 competition season. In parallel, we continued promoting CFA Institute scholarships and professional learning opportunities to help candidates and aspiring finance professionals advance their careers.

Beyond Türkiye, we further strengthened our presence across our Society territory, including Azerbaijan and Georgia. Through ongoing outreach efforts and the upcoming Charter Award Ceremonies in both countries, we remain committed to supporting charterholders, candidates, universities, and employers throughout the region.

Our digital community also continued to expand, with our LinkedIn audience surpassing 14,000 followers. Through educational content, event coverage, industry insights, and member engagement initiatives, we continue to foster connections among investment professionals across the region.

This period also marked an important governance milestone for our Society. Following our Annual General Meeting, we welcomed a newly elected Board of Directors and Audit Committee for the upcoming term. At the same time, we would like to express our sincere gratitude to all volunteers who have dedicated their time, expertise, and energy to serving the Society over the past year. We extend special thanks to those Board and Alternate Board members whose terms concluded this year. Their commitment, leadership, and contributions have played an important role in strengthening our Society and supporting its continued growth and success.

As always, our achievements are only possible because of the support of our volunteers, members, speakers, sponsors, university partners, employers, and colleagues at CFA Institute. We thank all of you for your continued engagement and support, and we look forward to building on this momentum during the second half of 2026.

CFA Institute Research Challenge Local Final 2025-2026

13 February

The 18th Local Final of the CFA Institute Research Challenge was successfully held on 13 February 2026.

This year's challenge focused on Türk Telekom as the subject company. Reports prepared by participating teams were meticulously evaluated by CFA Charterholder graders in early January, after which the top teams qualified for the Local Final. During the final presentations, the judging panel assessed the teams' equity research analyses, valuation methodologies, and presentation skills to determine the winning teams advancing to the next stage of the competition.

This year's challenge brought together:

- * 31 universities
- * 43 teams
- * 236 participants, including students and faculty advisors

The competition included participants from Türkiye (Ankara, Eskişehir, Istanbul, and Izmir), Azerbaijan, Uzbekistan, and the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus, reflecting the growing regional impact of the program.

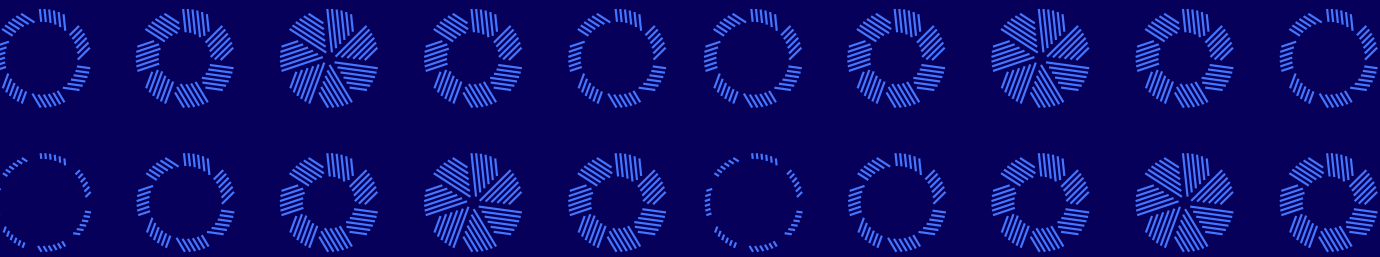

The session was moderated by M. Sinan Veziroğlu, whose dynamic moderation contributed to the interactive and engaging atmosphere of the panel.

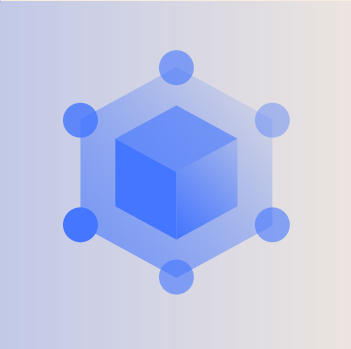
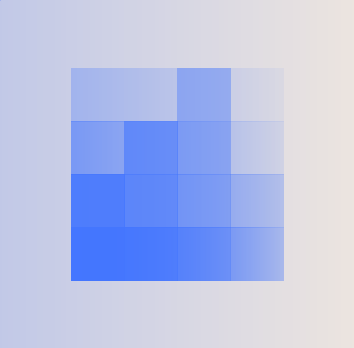

All about the CFA® Program

The Chartered Financial Analyst (CFA®) Program is designed to equip candidates with the knowledge and skills necessary to compete and excel in today’s complex and evolving investment industry.

The CFA Program is a three-part exam that tests the fundamentals of investment tools, valuation across various asset classes, portfolio construction, and ethical and professional standards.

The curriculum is developed by CFA Institute, one of the world’s leading associations of investment professionals. By enlisting the investment industry’s brightest minds to continually improve the CFA Program, CFA Institute ensures that the curriculum is always relevant and provides real- world skills in investment analysis.

TEST CENTERS

Exams are hosted in over [400 testing centers](#) located in most major cities around the world. Availability in test centers will vary by market. Schedule your exam appointment by the deadline (typically 60 days before the start of the exam window). Appointments are based on first-come, first-served basis. Candidates can take the exam a maximum of twice each calendar year but not in consecutive windows or windows that are six months or less apart. Candidates will have a total of six maximum attempts per exam level.

CFA PROGRAM FEES* BY EXAM LEVEL

Registration costs vary depending on when a candidate decides to register for the exam. An early registration period is available for all three levels, which reduces the exam fee. See table below. All fees must be paid in US dollars.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Registering for the CFA exam is a two-step process:

- **Step 1**
Enroll in the CFA exam through the CFA Institute website www.cfainstitute.org/programs/cfa-program
- **Step 2**
After the registration process is complete and payment processed, candidates will be able to schedule their exam via a Prometric scheduling tool, which presents available testing centers with dates and times. This step must be completed by the scheduling deadline.

STUDY MATERIALS

Passing the three exams marks true mastery of the curriculum and is the most important task required to earn the CFA® charter. On average, candidates report investing over 300 hours of study in advance of successfully passing each level. Becoming a CFA charterholder takes hard work and commitment. When you are a candidate, complete support is provided through the Learning Ecosystem, that helps candidates to prepare for the exam, available online and as an app. CFA Institute provides candidates with access to a wealth of information that will help them to pass the CFA exams and excel in their career.

CFA Institute provides the full curriculum in a comprehensive digital Learning Ecosystem to all registered candidates. It includes practice questions, mock exams, and more.

[Practice Packs](#) are available for all three exam levels and include a suite of additional prep materials, such as extra practice questions, exam day experience and mock exams from the authors of the CFA Program. They are available for purchase either at registration or at anytime before your exam day.

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

To enroll in CFA Program and register for the Level I CFA exam, you must have an international travel passport and meet one of the following entrance requirements:

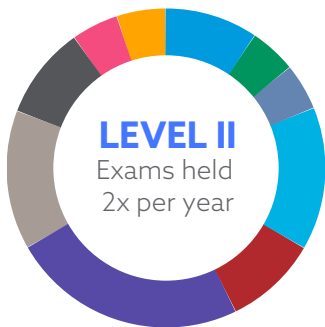
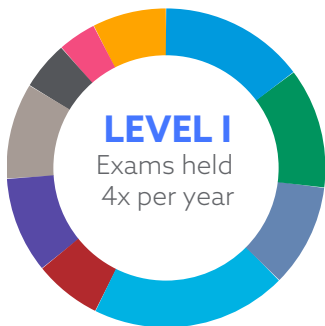
-  **Bachelor's Degree**
Complete a bachelor's program or equivalent program and received a university/college degree. If you're not sure if your program is comparable, ask your college or university.
-  **Final-Year Student**
Be within 11 months of your graduation month for your bachelor's degree or equivalent program on the date of sitting for the Level I exam.
-  **Professional Work Experience**
Have a combination of 4,000 hours of work experience and/or higher education that was acquired over a minimum of three sequential years on the date of enrolling for the Level I exam. Dates of education and professional work experience cannot be overlapping.

ACCESS SCHOLARSHIP

For individuals who may not be able to afford the program fees and have not yet registered for their next exam. Exam registration reduced to USD300.



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

For students currently attending an affiliated university and have not yet registered for their next exam. Exam registration reduced to USD400.



PROFESSOR SCHOLARSHIP

REGULATOR SCHOLARSHIP

For employees of financial regulators, central banks, securities commissions, stock exchanges, SROs, or government entities that oversee or regulate the investment management industry and have an agreement with CFA Institute. Applicants must be directed by their employer to apply. Program enrollment fee waived (if applicable) and exam registration reduced to USD 600.
