“2018 Changed It All”

We are about to embark on our first filing season under the tax reform changes brought on by the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act which passed nearly a year ago. The IRS is currently issuing regulations and a steady rate to help explain these law changes before returns need to be filed. Find out what changes construction industry firms and their owners can expect and get caught up on the latest regulations issued to date.
