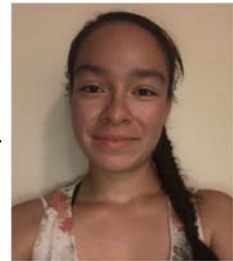
What do you think is the best movie ever made?
