Number of Prescription: 103

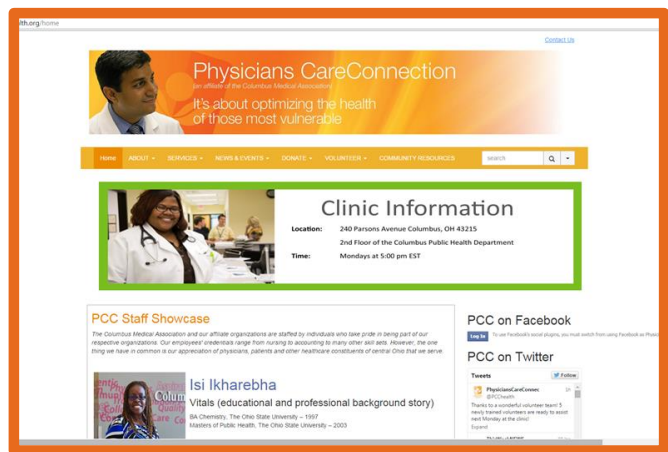


## PCC HEALTH WEBSITE

At the end of 2015 Physicians CareConnection was awarded a grant by CelebrateOne, a group created by the Greater Columbus Infant Mortality Task Force. This group was tasked with carrying out the recommendations from the Task Force to take on the most significant factors leading to high infant mortality:

1. Babies born too small or too soon
2. Sleep related deaths
3. Exposure to tobacco smoke during and after pregnancy
4. Health inequities

Physicians CareConnection, with the grant awarded, will work to help women who are pregnant schedule and attend their first pre-natal appointment. This requires relationship building with obstetric providers and practices and most importantly working to build trusting relationships with our clients.
