Online Training Curriculum and Tabletop Exercise

## Overview

Cultural heritage is critical infrastructure. During a disaster, the local Alliance for Response (AFR) Network is the bridge between state and local emergency management, first responders, and collecting institutions. To ensure your AFR is prepared and to build network capacity, FAIC has developed an asynchronous online training course and a concluding tabletop exercise. The program includes 12 hours of content, with an option to add on a two-day in-person training.
