

- New stock coming onto the market








Ipswich City Council



- Workforce of 63,000
- GRP of \$4.3 billion and estimated to grow to \$12.7 billion by 2025
- 40 minutes from CBD
- 60 minutes from BAC
- Turn-key lease from \$90/m² (average \$150/m²)
- Raw land from \$150/m²
- New stock constantly coming onto the market with 43% of all available industrial land in SEQ being within Ipswich LGA





Logan City



- Workforce of 152,400
- GRP of \$8.1billion
- 20 minutes from CBD
- 25 minutes from BAC
- Turn-key lease from \$110/m²
- Raw land from \$120/m²
- New industrial land corridors being developed, particularly south west Logan
