Eligibility Criteria

- Either the nominator or nominee must be a **CoreNet Global Service Provider member** or an employee of our Singapore Chapter annual sponsor in good standing.
- Team has to be Singapore based and nominee must work and reside in Singapore.
- Achievements occurring from **1 May 2025 – 30 April 2026**.
- Professionals who serve corporate real estate end users in professional disciplines such as project, facilities, or property management, design, engineering, construction, and other advisory services, or complementary services that directly impact the built environment.
- Singapore Chapter Board Members are exempted.
- Last year's category winner is ineligible for this year's award.

Submission Guidelines:

- Ensure nomination include clear evidence of achievements and capture all relevant contributions. Nominations will be reviewed by senior members of the CRE profession and the quality of nomination should reflect this.

1. Demonstrated ability to exceed client expectations
