

Sustainability & Wellness Leadership Award

This award celebrates work that accelerates the adoption of environmentally friendly and socially responsible real estate practices.

Eligibility Criteria

- The sustainability project must have been executed by a team based in the CoreNet Global Australia region.
- The sustainability project team must include a CoreNet Global member or be an Australian Chapter sponsor in good standing.
- The sustainability project must have been completed after 1 January 2023.
- Last year's category winner is excluded from this year's category award

Clarifications

• Submissions may include a project team with representatives from more than one company, however only one prize will be awarded. Applicants are required to nominate a representative company and individual.

Submission Criteria

1. Environmental & Wellness Impact (max 500 words - 50% weighting)

Describe the project's environmental and wellness impact, including outcomes and measures taken to:

- Reduce absolute emissions (Scope 1, 2 and 3, waste etc) during design, build and operations (25% weighting)
- Enhance the occupants health, safety and wellbeing (25% weighting)
- 2. Innovation & Process Improvement (max 250 words 15% weighting)

Describe any innovative approaches, initiatives or technologies used in the project that assess value specifically to the project's outcomes.

3. Collaboration (max 250 words - 15% weighting)

Describe how the project team collaborated with stakeholders (e.g. end-users, tenants, contractors, suppliers, authorities, communities) to shape and enhance the project's outcomes.

4. Leadership (max 250 words - 20% weighting)

Describe how the project demonstrates leadership in sustainability and wellness related corporate real estate practices
