

Workplace Innovation Award

This award recognises outstanding projects in Australia that showcase innovation in areas such as design, real estate utilisation, functionality, and technology. This award acknowledges projects that have contributed to an organisation's mission and helped establish its successful position in the Australian market.

Eligibility Criteria

- The workplace project must have been executed by a team based in the CoreNet Global Australia region
- The workplace project team must include a CoreNet Global member or be an Australian Chapter sponsor in good standing.
- The workplace project must have been completed after 1 January 2023.
- Last year's category winner is excluded from this year's category award.

Clarifications

• Submissions may include a project team with representatives from more than one company, however only one prize will be awarded. Applicants are required to nominate a representative company and individual.

Submission Criteria

1. Strategy and Vision (max 250 words - 20% weighting)

Describe how the client's organisational objectives were incorporated into the workplace strategy and vision

2. Innovation (max 400 words - 15% weighting)

What innovative design or technological solutions were implemented to improve the workplace environment, productivity, and/or employee experience?

3. Outcomes (max 400 words - 35% weighting

How has the workplace project contributed to the organisation's success, and what measurable outcomes have been achieved as a result?

4. Lesson (max 400 words - 30% weighting)

What unique challenges did the workplace project face, and how were they overcome through innovative design, real estate utilisation, functionality, and/or technology?
