

Technology Innovation Award

This award celebrates outstanding projects that showcase innovation in the adoption of technology in real estate to enhance the workplace experience and achieve corporate objectives.

Eligibility Criteria

- The workplace project must have been executed by a team based in the CoreNet Global Australia region
- The workplace project team must include a CoreNet Global member or be an Australian Chapter sponsor in good standing.
- The workplace project must have been completed after 1 January 2025.
- Last year’s category winner is excluded from this year’s category award.
- If the award sponsor chooses to write a feature article on the winner, we kindly ask that you make yourself available at a mutually convenient time

Clarifications

- Submissions may include a project team with representatives from more than one company, however only one prize will be awarded. Applicants are required to nominate a representative company and individual.

Submission Criteria

1. **Strategic Alignment** (max 250 words - weighting 5%)
 - How did the project align with the client’s corporate strategy and values?
2. **Project Objectives & Challenges** (max 400 words - weighting 15%)
 - What were the primary project objectives?
 - What unique challenges related to Technology did the project want to overcome?
3. **Metrics & Performance** (max 250 words - weighting 15%)
 - What were the defined key metrics to measure project success?
 - How were these metrics tracked and assessed throughout the project lifecycle?

Example metrics

- *Workplace environment*
- *Productivity*
- *Employee experience/engagement*
- *Employee attraction/retention*

4. **Innovation** (max 1000 words - weighting 25%)

- Describe how innovative technology initiatives were incorporated into the project.
- How did these innovations set the project apart in the marketplace?

Examples

- *Incorporating new technologies in design and operations*
- *Using existing technologies in a new way*
- *Use of data analytics, IoT, AI, VR technologies to achieve project outcomes*

5. **Stakeholder Engagement** (max 250 words - weighting 10%)

- How did you engage employees, stakeholders, or the community in the design and innovation process?

6. **Outcomes & Impact** (max 400 words - weighting 30%)

- What were the final outcomes achieved, and how did they align with the defined objectives and key metrics?
- How did the project exceed or fall short of initial goals?

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
