

The following is a generic role description for Community Leads & Community Committee Members.

Our vision is for Communities to become the heart and soul of the Chapter. As such Community Leads and Community Committee Members play a key role in the future of our Chapter. Becoming involved in the leadership of a Chapter Community is a great opportunity to get involved in the industry, give something back and meet new people.

Community Lead

Purpose of Role: To lead the [SPP] community so that it is an active group valued by chapter members.

Responsibilities:

- Create and lead a [SPP] community committee ideally comprising of at least three chapter members & a representative from young leaders
- Work with the committee to develop strategy & goals (the community plan) for the group
- Identify key issues or areas of interest to the Community
- Align goals and activities of the community with the corenet values of connect, learn, belong and grow
- Develop the community to become the meeting place for members to share their experiences and ideas in both online & in person forums
- It is expected that as a minimum a community will organize and host 1 x free to members event and 1 x white paper/research paper every 12 months
- To identify and manage resources required in delivering the activities of the community
- Collaborate with other communities and/or interest groups to share knowledge and ideas
- Be accountable for delivering the "community plan"
- Provide a monthly progress update report to the Chapter board

Requirements:

• It is anticipated that a community lead will be able to commit time as necessary (as a guide at least one day a month) leading the community

Community Committee Member

Purpose of Role: To work with the Community lead and other committee members in delivering the plan for the community

Responsibilities:

- Work with the Community Lead informing the goals & objectives for the community (the community plan)
- Champion the community to chapter members driving engagement
- Bring forward key issues or areas of interest to the Community
- Contribute to community discussion/activity for members to share their experiences and ideas in both online & in person forums

• Work with the Community Lead & Committee to organize and host 1 x free to members event and 1 x white paper/research paper every 12 months

Requirements:

• It is anticipated that a community committee member will be able to commit time as necessary (as a guide at least one day a month) to the community
