



YOUNG LEADER OF THE YEAR

Entries are open for the 2020 CoreNet Young Leader of the Year Award. This award recognises the Young Leader of the Year who showed a dedication and enthusiasm for his/her work, exemplifies excellence and should be considered 'one to watch' in the broad field of corporate real estate (CRE) in any member category. The UK award winner will be put forward for the Global Young Leader of the Year Award.

Nomination deadline

19th June

Entry Criteria

- Aged 35 or under on 25 October 2020
- End-user, service provider or other influencer in the CRE sector
- Based anywhere in the UK
- Have been employed within the CRE industry in the UK for the past year
- Paid Young Leader Member of CoreNet Global (must be age 35 or younger by October 2020)*
- Actively engaged member over the previous 12 months (examples of engagement may include but are not limited to: attended a Summit, MCR candidate or other designation (LEED, registered architect, surveyor, ...))

* If not a paid Young Leader Member application can be made as part of awards submission process.

Submission process

Entries can be through nomination or self-submission.

Entrants/nominations should:

- Demonstrate how they have used best practice and implemented initiatives or innovations (however small) that have positively impacted the CRE profession in the UK over the past three years. Provide at least two examples. Max 400 words.
- Demonstrate how they have delivered quantifiable achievements that have contributed to their employer's success, or their clients' success if they work for a service provider, over the past three years. Max 400 words.
- Discuss how they have been actively involved in the corporate real estate industry (including CoreNet) over the past year. Max 400 words.
- Show how they are actively pursuing professional development within the CRE industry. Max 400 words.
- Set out their views on the future of the real estate industry in the UK - what needs to change? Where is the industry going? What are its strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats? Max 400 words.

Submissions can be in any medium – written, video or audio or any other form. If written, the above word counts must be taken into account and the entire submission should be no longer than five sides of A4 in total with a minimum font size of 10. Videos and podcasts should be no longer than 10 minutes.
