McKinleyville Community Services District

Started in the 1890s as a place to provide services for gold miners and timber workers, the McKinleyville Community Services District was officially created in 1970. It now offers a wide array of essential services to its community. This district not only provides water management and lighting, but also parks and recreation, in addition to library services.



Tahoe City Public Utility District

This special district is the oldest local government in the Tahoe Basin and was initially formed to provide public water services to the local community. These days, the Tahoe City Public Utility District is committed to enhancing residents' and visitors' quality of life through managing parks, maintaining sanitation services, and providing safe, reliable water.



Menlo Park Fire Protection District

Rich in history, the Menlo Park Fire Protection District's mission is to protect and preserve life and property from the impact of fire, disaster, injury, and illness. Among other achievements, this fire protection district was the first fire agency in San Mateo County to have paramedics on each fire engine. Since 1915, the Menlo Park Fire Protection District has saved countless lives, educated the public, and contributed to community improvement.



Clovis Veterans Memorial District

Clovis Veterans Memorial District was created to honor and serve the veterans in their community who have proudly served and protected our nation. In addition to offering support resources to veterans in the Clovis area, the Clovis Veterans Memorial District also provides a permanent living memorial to all United States Veterans.



Orange County Mosquito and Vector Control District

Dedicated to protecting public health by controlling vector and pest threats, the Orange County Mosquito and Vector Control District has kept its community safe for over 60 years. This mosquito and vector control district provides county-wide surveillance programs and responds to almost 20,000 citizen requests each year. The district supports education programs that are shared throughout the county at schools, civic group meetings, and other community events.
