




How is the COVID-19 pandemic affecting your district's budget?




Have you had - or, do you anticipate the immediate need - to let employees go or be furloughed?




What ADDITIONAL expenses are you incurring as your special district responds to COVID-19 pandemic? (Check all that apply)




Do you expect your special district will take any of the following actions in response to the economic and fiscal impacts of COVID-19 in the next six months?






Did your district have an emergency plan?




How costly do you anticipate the new unfunded federal mandate to provide emergency public health paid family leave to impacted employees will be to your district?






Has your special district re-purposed facilities and/or personnel to respond to the needs of your community and/or the State of California in the face of the COVID-19 pandemic?



Have you closed, canceled, or postponed any district operations, activities, programs, or actions?




Do you have access to broadband internet service?




- Yes, broadband is readily available in my community


Does your district have sufficient technical ability to conduct district operations remotely?




If your special district provides fire protection, ambulance, paramedic, or other public safety services, what is that status of testing your personnel for COVID-19?
