Dues are based on your agency's annual operating revenue/income as of June 30, 2017. Only one-time grants or straight pass-through funding should be excluded from this calculation. Any funding used to support agency operations such as payroll and other administrative expenses should be included. CSDA dues are adjusted annually to reflect the CPI and may be subject to change by majority vote of the CSDA Board of Directors.

OBRA 1993 prohibits taxpayers from deducting, for federal income tax purposes, the portion of membership dues that are allocable to the lobbying activities of trade organizations. The nondeductible portion of your dues is estimated to be 8%.
