CSI is the construction community's authority on communication and construction documentation. Through CSI's Certification Program, you can strengthen and demonstrate your understanding of the entire construction process and concrete skills in:

- > Construction documentation development and administration
- Specification writing and enforcement
- > Product research and sourcing
- > Communication with the design and contracting teams

CSI's Certifications: Construction Document Technologist (CDT), Certified Construction Contract Administrator (**CCCA**), Certified Construction Specifier (**CCS**), and Certified Construction Product Representative (**CCPR**).

CSI offers CDT, CCCA, CCPR, and CCS examinations twice annually in spring and fall.

Open registration for the test begins in the winter and summer respectively.
