ALFRED W. SIKES graduated from the University of Illinois before entering the U. S. Army. While in the Army he attended Carnegie Institute of Technology and received a Master of Science degree in Metallurgical Engineering.

Sikes retired as a Colonel after 32 years of Army service and began working for the Chicago Park District Engineering Department. He joined CSI as a member-at-large shortly after

the Institute was organized. When efforts were started to form a CSI chapter in Chicago, he joined the group and later served as the chapter's first president.

In 1958, he was advanced to Distinguished Membership.
