HENRY T. J. MARTIN was a native of England. He joined CSI in 1954 as a member at large, and immediately began efforts to charter a chapter in Dallas. His efforts bore fruit and the chapter was chartered in 1957. He was selected to serve as the chapter's first president.

In 1958, Martin was elected to a three year term on the Institute Board as Institute Director for Region 9. During his term as Director, he assisted in organizing and chartering chapters in Houston, Austin, Fort Worth, and Oklahoma City.

During Martin's second year on the Board, he was appointed chairman of the Institute's Technical Committee T-2 General Conditions Study. He served in this capacity until the end of his term on the Board. Upon completion of his term, he was appointed to the Institute's Technical Review Board.

In 1966, the Dallas Chapter established a special award in his honor that is awarded only to a member who has made significant contributions to the chapter and the Institute.

Martin was made an Honorary Member of the Institute in 1983.
