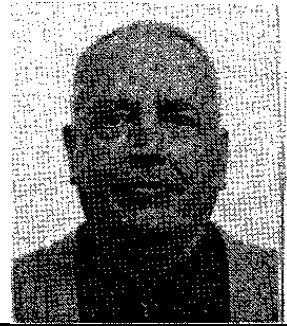


Elliot H. Gage, Jr.*, FCSI

ELLIOT HOWES GAGE was born in Memphis, Tennessee on January 27, 1923. He attended the Illinois Institute of Technology, graduating with a BS in Mechanical Engineering in January 1944. In 1950 he received a JD degree from DePaul University.

From 1946 through 1949, Gage was a staff engineer with the International Harvester Company. He joined S. J. Reynolds, Inc., as a staff engineer in 1950, and continued there until 1956. From 1956 until 1964, he was vice president of the Hunter Clark Ventilating Company. For the next three years he served as vice president of Alexander Gammie Plumbing and Heating. In 1957 he opened his own office as a consulting engineer.

Gage has always been active in Institute technical affairs. He served on the Institute's Technical Review Board, the T-5 Mechanical Committee, the T-6 Electrical Committee, and on the Engineering joint Contract Documents Committee (EJCDC).

In addition to his activities for CSI, Gage was active in many engineering organizations in and around Chicago. He served as President and director of the Illinois Chapter of ASHRAE. He also served as chair of the Construction Industry Affairs Council of Chicago (CIAC), and as president of the Chicago Engineers Club. He also was chair of the Mechanical Specialty Contractors/Consulting Engineers Liaison Committee.

Gage served as a member and later chair of the National Documents Committee for the American Consulting Engineers Council, and was as a member of the Registration Act Legislative Advisor Committee for Engineering and Architecture.

He was a Life Member of ASHRAE, and Member Emeritus of the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying.

Elliott received the EJCDC President's Plaque in 1987, and the Joseph N. Lucas Award in 1988.

Gage passed away on 4 February 2012.
