RONALD SHELDON STARKWEATHER was born in Madison, Wisconsin, in 1914..

During World War II, he served as a draftsman and engineer with the US Army Corps of Engineers. After the war, he attended the University of Wisconsin. After graduation, he joined the firm of John J. Flad and Associates, an organization of architects, engineers, and planners.

He rose through the firm's ranks to become Vice President and General Manager.

He joined CSI in 1957 when efforts were underway to charter a chapter in Madison. In 1959 he was elected Chapter President. In 1963, he served a term as Institute Director from Region 7.

Always an advocate of continuing education for the practitioner, Ronald was instrumental in developing the University of Wisconsin construction industry educational seminars that continue today.

Starkweather passed away on 13 August 1989, in Madison, Wisconsin.
