TERRY M. WADSWORTH was born in 1936 in Nogales, Arizona. He attended Texas A&M, where he received a BA in Architecture in 1959. Later, he took graduate studies at Arizona State University, Southern Methodist University, and the University of Wisconsin.

Wadsworth served in the U.S. Army Infantry as an airborne ranger. He graduated from the United States Army Command and General Staff School at Ft. Leavenworth. He served as a platoon leader in the 82nd Airborne, two years as a company commander in the 112th Armored Cavalry in Germany, two years as a company commander in the 1st Cavalry with 13 months in Viet Nam, and one year as a company commander of the 4th Infantry at Fort Lewis. After leaving active duty he

joined the Texas National Guard, where he served another eighteen years in command positions in Army aviation units. He retired from military reserve service as a lieutenant colonel in 1982.

Terry became a licensed architect in 1968, then worked with a number of major firms, and eventually established his own architectural firm. In 1993, he established Hill Haven Homes in Austin, Texas. From 1996 through 2010, Terry managed \$1.6 billion of construction programs for the Austin Independent School District.

Wadsworth passed away on 31 March 2017 at University Medical Center in Lubbock, Texas.
