DOUGLAS C. HARTMAN was born in Springfield, Illinois, in 1951. He attended the University of Illinois and attained a Bachelor of Architecture degree in 1973 and a Master of Architecture degree in 1976 from that institution.

From 1977 to 1985 he was Director of Construction Administration for HH Architects in Dallas and from 1985 he has been an independent specifications consultant with Inspec, Inc., in Dallas.

Hartman's contributions to enhancing the education and certification process for both specifiers and construction administrators are significant. He is the recipient of numerous citations and awards from the Dallas CSI Chapter and the South Central CSI Region.

In 1992, he served as chairman of an Ad Hoc committee of the Dallas Chapter in developing a twelve-credit-hour

curriculum in specifications writing. The program, developed in conjunction with the Department of Construction Management and Technology at North Lake College, Irving, Texas, allows students who successfully complete the four courses to immediately fill a role in a design professional's office as an entry level specifications writer.

In 1990, Hartman began to organize short courses in Construction Contract Administration for the Dallas Chapter. This ultimately led to his three-year appointment to the Institute Ad Hoc CCCA committee, where he contributed to development of ten new Manual of Practice chapters while concurrently developing the fifteen education units that are now being used to instruct students in construction contract administration. In December of 1995, the Dallas Chapter, with Hartman's assistance, utilized this education material in producing its first ten-week, 25 contact hour, CCCA exam preparation course.
