DUANE M. JOHNSON is a practicing architect, and co-founder and principal of Comstock Johnson Architects, Inc, located in the Sacramento, CA area. The 15-person firm, founded in 1982, was an early leader in Northern California for non-traditional delivery methods. The firm regularly associated with selected regional general contractors to produce projects in Negotiated or Design-Build teams for their developer clients. Johnson's early career was largely working on municipal and institutional projects. With this extensive background, he has provided expertise as his firm's Project Coordinator for most religious, bio-tech laboratory, and institutional projects. The broad scope of his work includes program development, preliminary design, and construction administration.

As a CSI member, Duane has brought this non-traditional thinking process to the committees and board positions he has served on to look for better or more cost-effective ways to meet CSI's goals. As an example, for many years he has been focused on making CSI "the educator's resource of choice". His recent work at a national level with accredited

Construction Management programs is patterned after a model developed in his home chapter with their Student Affiliate at Cosumnes River College. For over 20 years, the Chapter has actively supported the architecture program there in many ways, from speakers to panels, tours, résumé reviews, and an Institute award-winning annual Student Design Contest involving multiple schools. The lead professor has personally returned the support by engaging students in Chapter events. This has led to a much more consistent relationship than focusing on the individual students and re-starting the process every few years as they graduate. He claims the students keep him "thinking young" and it feeds into his chapter's motto, "Get the work done but have fun doing it."

Johnson has a Bachelor of Architecture Degree from California Polytechnic State University, San Luis Obispo. He serves on a Sacramento senior housing project, and is active on local Chamber of Commerce Governmental Affairs committees. He also served in the US Navy as an Electronic Technician.
